- GOAL 6: HUMANITIES THE ARTS, LITERATURE, AND PHILOSOPHY (HA)..9 cr**
 A minimum of 2 credits from each of 3 areas: Art, English Literature, Foreign Culture, Humanities*, JOUR 1106, Music, Philosophy*, Speech/Theatre.
