I. Minnesota Transfer Curriculum General Education Requirements.....30 Credits

Mathematics (MATH 1111 or higher)

Goal 6: Humanities—the Arts, Literature, and Philosophy (HA).....3 cr

Art, English Literature*, Foreign Culture, Humanities*, Journalism, Music,
Philosophy*, Speech/Theatre

MNTC General Education Electives.....14 cr

Any MNTC approved courses from the above areas. A.S. degrees require 6 goals be completed. Goal 2, Critical Thinking, is completed by passing any MNTC course. One additional goal (Goal 7, Human Diversity; Goal 8, Global Perspective; Goal 9, Ethic and Civic Responsibility or Goal 10, People & the Environment must be completed. (two credit minimum)

Any combination of Health courses (numbered 1102, 1109, 1110, 1111, 1114, 1132, 1135, 2126) and/or Physical Education Courses (numbered 1100-1199).

Any RCTC courses above 1000 level
