- Admission to the program will be based on total accumulation of points earned prior to the admission deadline.
 - Points will be awarded, as indicated above, for courses completed with grades of "B" (3.00) or better.
 - Points will only be awarded for the highest degree completed.
 - Two points will be awarded for a current MN State Registry (You need to provide proof). Acceptable proof includes:
 - Current (non-expired) Minnesota State Registry Card
 - If your card has not yet been issued, official documents stating the passing of both the Written and Skills
 - Official letter from the Minnesota Department of Health that shows active registry status past June 15, 2012.
 - Three points will be awarded for verification of employment with direct patient care (see form for details).
A new form is needed each time you apply. An older form will NOT be awarded points.

NURSING ASSISTANT REQUIREMENT

- Submit either an official college transcript with proof of successful completion of NA 1500 or equivalent OR
- Submit a copy of your MN State Registry card
- If completed at a college, the official transcript MUST be submitted.

CPR REQUIREMENT

- **CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer** – card **MUST** be valid past June 15th (attach copy of front and back of card)
- **HLTH 1110** – this is the RCTC course that satisfies this requirement (CPR does not need to be completed at RCTC)
- There are many different types of certification. If you are uncertain, please contact chris.wolf@roch.edu

TRANSCRIPTS

- Please submit official transcripts from **all** previously attended colleges
 - Your most current official transcripts need to be on file at RCTC prior to the admission deadline
- Only OFFICIAL transcripts will be accepted
 - Please request that the high school and college(s) mail the transcript(s) directly to RCTC
 - If delivered by you, official transcript(s) MUST be sealed in an envelope by the school
- UNOFFICIAL and INCOMPLETE transcripts will **NOT** be accepted
 - Faxed transcripts are unofficial
 - A broken or tampered envelope seal is unofficial
 - Missing grades, grades of incomplete, and missing graduation dates will be deemed incomplete
- Please allow 3 weeks from the date we receive your official transcript(s) for a transfer evaluation to be completed
- You do **NOT** need to submit a transcript from RCTC.

TRANSFER STUDENTS

- If a course is questionable, ALWAYS submit a detailed course syllabus (usually an issue with the algebra requirement)
 - If necessary, submit placement test results from other colleges (ACCUPLACER, COMPASS, etc.)
- If your major is something other than Practical Nursing, your transfer evaluation will NOT be correct
 - You may request, at the Admissions counter, to have your transcripts re-evaluated for Practical Nursing

NEW STUDENTS (No previous college experience)

- Submit a final official high school transcript with graduation date or GED
- Submit Accuplacer test results (attach to this application)
 - You MUST test into ENGL 1117 and MATH 0099 or higher to be eligible

As a prerequisite for applying to RCTC nursing programs, applicants need to complete a Nursing Assistant Course. This has proven to be a good opportunity for students to see if they desire to pursue a career in either nursing or other health careers. PRACTICAL NURSING (LPN) – FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How are students selected for Practical Nursing?

All applications submitted prior to the deadline (June 15) will be reviewed. Only students who have successfully completed the minimum qualifications will be considered for admission. Students will be ranked by earned points. Grades from all colleges, with the exception of developmental courses, will be factored into the cumulative GPA. The 40 most qualified students will be extended an offer to join the Practical Nursing program that year.

How is cumulative GPA calculated?

Your cumulative GPA, at the time of the admission deadline, will be used for admission purposes. A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.00 is required.

Cumulative GPA = GPA Points divided by GPA Credits for any and all attempted college credits (credits more than 10 years old will NOT be calculated).

What are the requirements for admission to Practical Nursing and what satisfies each of them?

High School Diploma or GED

- Final official high school transcript with graduation date
- GED

Cumulative College GPA at or above 2.0

- Calculation includes **any and all** attempted college credits (please see above for a more detailed description of the calculation)
- The sum of GPA Points divided by the sum of GPA Credits **MUST** be at least 2.00

Nursing Assistant

- Successful completion of NA 1500 at RCTC
- Successful completion of an equivalent course at an accredited school
- If not completed at an accredited school, you must submit a copy of your CNA Registry card

College Reading and Writing Skills

- ACCUPLACER placement into ENGL 1117 (you MUST attach ACCUPLACER results to this application)
- Successful completion of ENGL 1117 or equivalent

Elementary Algebra ("C" or better)

- ACCUPLACER placement into MATH 0099 or higher (you MUST attach ACCUPLACER results to this application)
- Successful completion of MATH 0098 or higher or equivalent
- Successful completion of CHEM 1117 or equivalent or ACT score of 21 or higher

Current CPR Certification (American Heart = Healthcare Provider or Red Cross = CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer or HLTH 1110 at RCTC)

- Copy of current CPR card (both sides of card)

Is there any other information I need to submit?

Please make sure that all information is submitted to RCTC prior to 4:30PM on the day of the deadline. RCTC will not request missing information. It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure that all information has been submitted prior to the deadline. If you haven't already done so, you need to apply to RCTC. If you were previously a student at RCTC and more than one year has passed since you were enrolled last, please submit the online application. Applications are available online at www.rctc.edu. If your transcripts were not evaluated for the Practical Nursing Program, please request that they be re-evaluated (Admissions and Records).

What if I am in the process of completing one or more of the requirements?

Only students who have successfully completed all admission requirements, prior to the deadline, will be offered admission. Should additional seats become available "in progress" students will be ranked by earned points and admitted accordingly. Those "in progress" will not be offered admission until the prerequisite coursework has been completed and grades have been posted. All qualified students will be offered admission before any "in progress" students.

What number am I on the list?

It is possible that you meet all of the qualifications, but do not get offered admission. This is because there were at least 40 applicants with a higher earned point total. As applicants decline our offer for admission, the next qualified applicant will be offered. If you are one of the top 15 "next qualified" applicants, you will be directed to a website to track your admission status.
