There IS a new waiver period within which an individual may apply to take the PLT license exam without having to furnish evidence of the required three years of experience. In accordance with the new law, this waiver goes into effect on December 1, 2007 and will end on December 30, 2007. Submit your paperwork to the State of MN by December 30, 2007!!!

Course Description:

This class introduces the aspiring Power Limited Technician to the knowledge base that is applicable to the holding of this "low voltage" license. The six (6) evenings of classes focuses on elements specifically associated with the PLT license and the PLT license examination. It covers the applicable portions of the National Electrical Code, the Minnesota Statutes and Rules, and relevant technology and mathematics. This class is applicable to all Professions and Trades.
