## **EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION TRANSFER PATHWAY AS**

**Purpose:** RCTC's Early Childhood Care and Education program offers a 25-credit certificate in Child Development and a 60-credit Transfer Pathway AS degree in Early Childhood Education. The Child Development certificate is embedded in the AS degree. The 25-credit certificate in Child Development meets the Minnesota Department of Human Services (DHS) educational requirement for assistant teachers and teachers in child care centers. DHS Rule 3 requires additional work experience to be hired as an assistant teacher or teacher. Students are encouraged to seek employment as a program assistant or child care assistant in a licensed early childhood program upon entrance to RCTC.
