Purpose: RCTC's Natural Science Associate of Science degree program is designed to articulate with a four year degree in the sciences. This two-year degree includes basic science curriculum to fulfill many requirements for pre-professional programs such as medicine, dentistry, chiropractic, and pharmacy.
