Surgical technologists play a vital role in ensuring safe, efficient, and successful surgical procedures. Surgical technologists are responsible for preparing the operating room, verifying sterility of instruments and supplies, and ensuring all necessary equipment is ready for each procedure. During surgery, the surgical technologist anticipates the needs of the surgical team, passing instruments and supplies, managing the sterile field, and maintaining a safe and organized environment.
