

Interested in Becoming a Child Care or School-Age Care Professional?

You may be eligible to receive up to **\$6,000** per year for up to two years (re-application necessary for second year) of college education through T.E.A.C.H. Early Childhood® MINNESOTA's Judy Lindman Memorial Scholars program.

Applications due March 15, 2013

Eligibility requirements

- High school senior in good standing enrolled in the public/alternative school system of Minnesota
- High school grade point average showing marked effort, improvement or success
- By fall 2013, have GED or high school diploma and be eligible to enroll full-time at a Minnesota state accredited community and/or technical college in an associate's degree program majoring in early childhood education or child development
- **Must meet at least one of the following criteria:** have a disability or a special need; **or** have a history of working directly with children (0-12) from underserved populations; **or** be a member of a community of color, migrant, immigrant or refugee community; **or** be an English as a second language learner

The Judy Lindman Memorial Scholars Program is a forgivable loan project of the Minnesota Child Care Resource & Referral Network. The loan is repayable through employment at a legally regulated child care or school age care program located in Minnesota.
