Classroom Level

- Action. Open and document one individual Closing the Loop assessment for the year.

Or, if student performance has met expectations, the new assessment cycle should focus on a different learning outcome. Feedback on the assessment will be provided by an ASL Liaison.

 - i. **Deadline May 21, 2021**

- Description.

 - i. Deadline: December 2020
 - Interested faculty will work on a team along with ASL members and Student Affairs and Services members to analysis PPA college-wide results to identify gaps and suggest strategies to address the gaps.
 - o Communication (COMM) assessment implementation- Liaison, Annie Clement
 - i. Deadline: December 18, 2020 and May 12, 2021

- 1. Faculty teaching courses that declare Communication as an outcome will participate in the outcome's assessment.
- o Critical Thinking (CT) Assessment development and implementation-Liaison, Vacant
 - i. Deadline: December 2020
 - Faculty teaching courses that declare CT as an outcome will discuss and provide feedback on the Critical Thinking value statements and assessment tool.
 - ii. Deadline: May 2021
 - 1. Faculty teaching courses that declare CT as an outcome will participate in the outcome's assessment.
- o Global Awareness and Diversity (GAD) implementation- Liaison, Simona Baias
 - i. Deadline: December 18, 2020
 - Faculty will participate in pilot implementation for Sense of Self GAD module in D2L/Brightspace providing resources and assessments for faculty to use in their courses.

 - 1. Full implementation of Sense of Self GAD module (all faculty)
 - 2. Evaluation of module use
