The IRS Data Retrieval Tool (DRT) is a tool designed to allow both you as the student and your parent(s) to transfer the information that was filed with the IRS back into your FAFSA application. In order to make sure this is a successful process, you must know the EXACT address that was used to file the tax return.

Step 1: Go to https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa

Step 2: You will either click 'Start Here' or 'Log In' depending on if you are a new or returning user.

Step 3: Enter your FSA ID username and password.

Step 4: Click "Make FAFSA Corrections."

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Step 7: If you are eligible to transfer your information, you will see the message on your screen, click "Link to IRS" blue box.



Step 8: The next screen you will see is indicating that you are leaving FAFSA on the web and going to the IRS website. Click the "Proceed to IRS Site" button.







Step 10: You are then taken to the IRS website. After reviewing the box that pops up, click "OK".



Step 11: The information that will be populated for you will be your name, last four of your Social Security Number, date of birth, and filing status you reported on the FAFSA.
