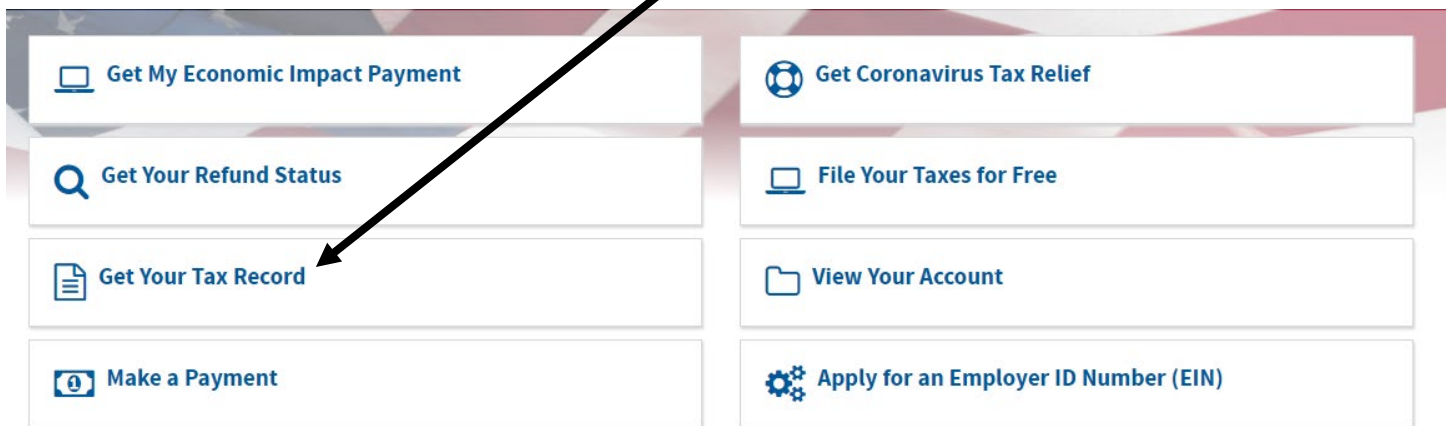


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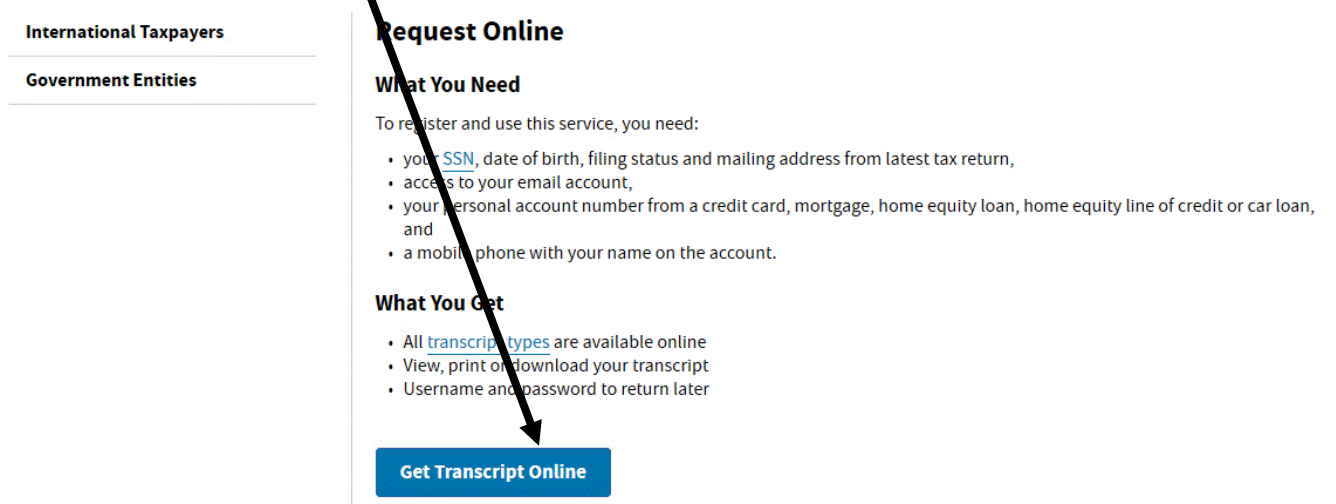
If you are not able to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool (DRT) on the FAFSA application you are able to obtain a free copy of your federal tax return transcript. Below are the instructions on how to obtain a free copy of your 2019 Federal Tax Return Transcript by creating an online account.

Step 1: Go to www.irs.gov.

Step 2: Click 'Get Your Tax Record'



Step 3: Part way down the page click 'Get Transcript Online'



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Step 4: If you already have an account with the IRS, enter your username and click log in. If you do not have an account with the IRS, then you will need to create one.

Step 5: Enter your password and click submit.

Step 6: You will receive a text message with a 6-digit security code, which will need to be entered. After entering the security code, click submit.

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Step 5: The next page you will see is your Online Security Information, which lists your login history. Click continue.

Step 6: From the drop down menu, select Higher Education/Student Aid as the reason you need a transcript. In the Customer File Number box, enter your Stinger ID number to be able to identify who the tax return transcript belongs too.

Step 7: Click, go.

Step 8: Under the Return Transcript box, click on 2019. This will open up another tab, which will allow you to print the tax return transcript. Please include the student's name and Stinger ID on the document and then submit to the Welcome and One Stop Center

Glossary

Return Transcript

Tax Return Transcripts show most line items from your tax return (Form 1040, 1040A or 1040EZ) as it was originally filed, including any accompanying forms and schedules. This transcript does not reflect any changes you, your representative or the IRS made after you filed your return. In many cases, a Return Transcript will meet the requirements of lending institutions offering mortgages and student loans.
